General Information

- The promoter of the competition is Kerala University of Health Sciences and Department of Community Medicine, Government Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram.
- The title of the competition is the '*MindMaze in Public Health Quiz*' competition.
- The theme for the quiz competition is Public Health with special focus on Mental Health.

Eligibility

- The '*MindMaze in Public Health Quiz*' is open to M.B.B.S. students (excluding CRR I) who have registered for the KUHS National Conference 2017.

Rules of the competition

- We have a limit of two members per team.
 - Members of a team should be from the same Medical College.
 - There will be a preliminary written screening round, to select participants for the finals.
 - There is no upper limit for the maximum number of teams from a college.
 - The Top 5 teams from the screening round will be selected for finals.
 - A maximum of 2 TEAMS only will be selected from ONE COLLEGE for the finals.
 - For e.g. in the case of more than two teams from the same college finishing in the top five position of the screening round, only TWO TEAMS with the highest score from that college qualifies. The other slots will be filled up by the next highest scoring team from a different college).
 - Prizes will be awarded for the TOP 3 teams.
